

Key Points of the DKI Jakarta Governor Regulation no. 88 (2020) on the Implementation of Large Scale Social Restriction for COVID-19 Control in the Special Capital Region of Jakarta Province

- The Governor can temporarily halt the Transition Period; a change in rules & regulations in regard to the Large-Scale Social Restriction (LSSR) in Jakarta considering the current cases
- Article 8, on schools and educational institutions
 - COVID-19 prevention measures to be done at school grounds/institution facilities through disinfection and enforcing COVID prevention protocols
- Article 9, on working in offices/workplace
 - Work from Home (WFH) mechanisms for all employees are to be arranged
 - Maximum capacity for people to be in the workplace at the same time: 25%
 - COVID-19 prevention measures to be done in the workplace through disinfection and access restriction to parties of no interest
 - To halt all activities in the workplace at least 3 x 24hrs if an employee is to be found with COVID-19
 - To protect workers infected with COVID-19 in accordance with the existing rules and regulations
- Article 10, on workplace categories excused from the temporary restriction laws
 - Foreign Country Representative offices and/or International Organisations in doing their diplomatic and consular functions as well as other functions in accordance with international law
 - State-Owned Enterprises involved in dealing with COVID and/or the supplying of basic needs, following the laws from related ministries and/or the Jakarta Government
 - Businesses in the following sectors:
 - Health
 - Food and beverages
 - Energy
 - Communication and Information Technology
 - Finance
 - Logistics
 - Hospitality
 - Construction
 - Strategic Industries
 - Basic services, public utilities and industries designated as national vital objects and certain objects
 - Basic needs
 - Local and international community organisations that operate in the disaster and social sectors
 - Workplace heads of the aforementioned sectors are to strictly ensure and enforce the health and safety protocols enforced by the Jakarta Government
- Article 11
 - Religious activities done in religious facilities/other public places in Jakarta can be done with a maximum capacity of 50%, and in accordance with the Government health and safety protocols
- Article 13, on the provision of basic needs

- The provision of goods online/via delivery are to be prioritized
- Occasionally disinfect locations
- Detect the body temperatures of employees and visiting customers
- Enforce physical distancing among customers and make sure employees are wearing proper work attire
- Article 18, on transportation and its means
 - Cars are to be only filled with a maximum of 2 people per row, with exceptions of people with the same residence
 - Public transportations are to operate with a maximum capacity of 50% and with limited operational hours
- Article 20, on COVID-related measures and regulated isolations
- The document also includes further detailed elaboration on the Enforcement of the Health and Safety Protocols
